Eclectics International	 Did not furnish a statement of no conflict of interest; Did not submit a copy of certificate of Registration by the PPDA or its equivalent; Did not submit a statement indicating the firm is not insolvent in receivership, bankrupt or being wound up; Did not submit an ISO:9001 certification; Did not submit a National Information Technology Authority-Uganda (NITA-U) certificate; Did not provide local representation; Lacked the relevant experience as they have not implemented at least one system

The demonstrated experience is for financial solutions and not gaming; • Did not provide a staff for the test lead role; • Did not submit a reference letter from a Government Authority or its concessionaire confirming the successful implementation of NCEMS in the gaming industry. • Technical criteria; the bidder's response to the technical requirement was not proof enough to demonstrate the required capability i.e. responses such as "we can do" did not substantially demonstrate technical capacity.

4.	African Computer Equipment Suppliers (PTY) LTD	 Inconsistencies in the trading license; the bidder(s) changed name from M/s African Casino Equipment Suppliers (PTY) Ltd to M/s African Computing Equipment Suppliers (PTY) Ltd on 31st January 2018. The trading license was issued on 1st April 2018 to M/s African Casino Equipment Suppliers (PTY) Ltd yet the bidder(s) had already changed its name; Did not submit a copy of certificate of Registration by the PPDA or its equivalent; Inconsistencies in the statement indicating that the firm is not insolvent; in receivership, bankrupt or being wound up, is not suspended by any Authority, PPDA in Uganda or debarred to participate in any

procurement by any authority in the region or any donor such as World Bank, EU. The Director, Clifford Managing in his declaration dated Lamberton, 24/11/2018 presented himself Director in M/s African Computer Equipment Suppliers (PTY) Ltd and in the same statement makes reference to M/s African Casino Equipment (PTY) Ltd (ACES) which had already changed its name to "African Computer Equipment Suppliers (PTY) Ltd" as per change of name certificate 111648656, referenced as 31/01/2018; which makes the declaration null and void.

- Did not prove fulfilment of their obligation to pay social security contributions in Uganda or elsewhere the business is located, with proof of a copy of certificate for social security contribution. The bidder(s) only provided evidence of payroll taxes which is not contribution to social security contribution;
- Did not submit a valid ISO:9001 certification. The bidder(s) submitted an ISO: 9001 certificate for another bidder(s) "Microtronix Manufacturing CC Randburg" that has no joint venture agreement with Microtronix Manufacturing Randburg deals in the assembly of electronic circuit board, including vehicle tracking devices and other electronic and local turnkev solutions for and markets international manufacturing of secondary vehicle lights which is not relevant to the subject of procurement;
- Did not submit a NITA-U certificate;
- The bidder(s) did not submit a local representative which was a must requirement for foreign consultancy firms. The bidder(s) only submitted a document stating that it believed it premature to enter into any firm agreement with a local bidder(s);



- Inadequate experience in development of NCEMS. This is evidenced in the bidder's submission on experience which only refers to a "reporting module" as opposed to a full NCEMS:
- Did not submit letter of reference from a government authority or its concessionaire confirming the successful implementation of NCEMS in the gaming industry which was a must requirement;
- Had an average annual turnover which was less than the required average annual turnover;
- The bidder(s) exhibited a Conflict of interest by presenting themselves providers of slot machines contrary to the Expression of Interest requirement that the bidder should not be a provider/operator of gaming machines, electronic terminals or systems in Uganda nor is holder of licenses in Uganda elsewhere. This is evidenced by the Trading License submitted; which was issued for manufacturing, of business distribution, repairing and maintenance of gambling devices; and the company profile submitted also stated that the bidder offers a range of second hand or used slots leading international machines from manufacturers that have been refurbished to factory standards.
- Technical criteria; the solution described in the bidder's response was on supply and operation of slot machines; which is inadequate to meet the competence required for the subject of procurement.



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- Did not submit certification of systems from established international testing laboratories (e.g. GLI, BMM etc...);
- Did not provide evidence of the experience required in the EOI i.e. implementation of at least one system of a Government Authority or its concessionaire in the gaming industry;
- Did not submit letter of reference from a Governmental Authority or its concessionaire confirming the successful implementation of NCEMS in the gaming industry;
- Technical criteria; did not demonstrate capacity to develop and implement the required solution. The bidder(s) only demonstrated capability in data management and the additional information provided was generic on gaming as whole.
