
Key Facts on MAPE

- Implementing partners: OPM, MoFPED, Uganda Police Forces, LGs and CSOs & Private Sector under CfP
- > Duration: Aug 2018 July 2023
- Coverage: Karamoja, Teso, Acholi, Lango and West Nile (37 districts) – See map below

Brief on the Actions

 MAPE Result 1: Improved skilling and employability of youth; support of FA objective 1

- Implementers OPM PMU
- Coverage 37 districts
- Train up to 1,250 youth (30% of women).
- Working through BTVET
- Internship & apprenticeship programmes

2. MAPE Result 2: Fostered accountability and transparency – Baraza's and Budget Transparency Initiatives; support of FA objective 3

- Implementers OPM, MoFPED & Targeted DLG
- Coverage 5 districts: Amuria, Moroto, Pader, Oyam & Zombo.



Brief on the Actions - Cont'd

3. MAPE Result 3: Improved safety and security in Karamoja; support of FA objective 3

- Implementer Uganda Police Forces
- Coverage 8 districts (Moroto, Amudat, Abim, Kaabong, Kotido, Napak, Nakapiripirit, & Nabilatuk.
- Construct 8 Police posts, one in each of the districts.
- Provide equipment solar panels, furniture, motorcycles
 & boreholes.
- Train 500 Police officers in community policing.
- Sensitize Police Officers on Human Rights.



Brief on the Actions - Cont'd

4. MAPE Result 4: Improved extension service delivery to farmers for enhanced performance of production departments; **support of FA objective 3**

- Implementers OPM PMU / DLG
- Coverage 16 core districts: Adjumani, Moyo, Yumbe, Zombo, Agago, Lamwo, Omoro, Pader, Alebtong, Kole, Otuke, Oyam, Amuria, Abim, Amudat and Moroto.
- Enhance knowledge & skills of 650 LPD & CBS staff.
- Equip and facilitate LPD staff (depending on the gap).
- Enhance capacities of Production Department to collect, analyze and utilize agricultural data.

- 1. 8 sites for the Police Post were identified and preliminary verification concluded.
- 2. Call for concept note for DINU concluded and being launched today.
- 3. Work plans discussed and agreed with MoFPED, OPM (Baraza) and Police.

4. Mational and District engagement mechanisms established.



Potential Complementarities

- 1. Youth engagement/employability.
- 2. Strengthening the capacities of DLGs in agricultural extension services including innovation.
- 3. Strengthening community accountability systems and engagement in planning service delivery.
- 4. Integrating interventions that promote the rule of law and strengthening referral systems.
